## Investing in Innovation: 2025-2026 Grant Recipients Announced

The NCTA Grants Committee is proud to announce the recipients of the **2025–2026 NCTA Professional Development Grant**: **Duke University** and **Binghamton University**! Binghamton University and Duke University have been awarded funding for their outstanding proposals to enhance professional testing and assessment practices.

- **Duke University** will host a one-day statewide conference to support academic testing staff in better serving neurodivergent students. The event will bring together professionals from 18 institutions across North Carolina to share evidence-based practices and build a collaborative network, with insights shared nationally through NCTA.
- **Binghamton University** will expand its STAMP conference into a two-day professional development event for SUNY institutions, fostering innovation, collaboration, and improved student support across the system.
