Barcoding Paper Exams Using RegisterBlast & Microsoft Office. Presented by Carrie Soloman, Director of the University Testing Center at Binghamton University.

Description

Would you like to learn a new method to keep track of your exams digitally? Using the RegisterBlast Exam Roster report, we have created dynamic labels for our exams which can be scanned into a database for searching later. Come find out how one testing center programmed Microsoft Excel, Word, and Access to create QR Codes for our exams and think about ways that your team might implement something similar for your paper-based exams. RegisterBlast is not required to use these tools, only the Microsoft Office Suite. This is customizable and suitable for both large and small testing centers.

Bio:

Carrie Solomon is the Director of the University Testing Center, Director of University Tutorial Services, and the Program Administrator for the Smart Energy Scholars Program at Binghamton University. After obtaining a Bachelors of Arts in Anthropology from the University of Louisville, she completed a Masters of Science in Biomedical Anthropology at Binghamton University.
