Institution pay

- Per exam
- Per user
- Site license

Student pay

- Per exam
- Flat fee

Accessibility

- What makes it accessible?
- Does it work with assistive technology your testtakers may use?
- Does it create any barriers for your test-takers?
- Are there multiple ways to get support?



Workflow

- Compatibility with other technology
- Process changes
- Training needs
- Benefits and potential barriers



Integration

- Integration with your LMS
- Improve processes or shift workloads
- Where are exam sessions stored
- How does it interact with test-takers
- Test-taker data collection

Support and customer service

- Training resources
- Support for test-takers, instructors, and staff
- Critically examine satisfaction ratings
- Customer service/exam integrity
